Liaisons Report Out	<p>CSHP Board (Samantha)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In person strategic planning meeting in July – BOD met to discuss topics such as how to incorporate and work with the CSHP Foundation, review bylaws and administrative policies, look at short-term and long-term goals for CSHP as an organization (focus on membership engagement and growth) - CONL is now a CCTF, formerly a standalone group – this change was made after discussion at strategic planning meeting and August BOD meeting - CSHP Seminar registration still available, early bird has passed <p>Government Affairs Committee (Brigitte)</p>

- AB1503 – CA BOP Sunset Review Bill; BOP is in pharmacy bc of a law that establishes the BOP. Every 5 years it must be renewed
- Focus on transforming pharmacy affordability and care; a lot of amendments based on what CSHP wants BOP to refine based on how pharmacists currently practice. Trying to establish standard of care for pharmacists similar to for other medical providers
- Expands APP, therapeutic interchanges, OTC, point of care testing, establishes pharmacist as healthcare professionals
